### FAQs

#### Docent-Led Tours – for students and adults

- last for one hour
- are designed to accommodate between 10 and 60 people per one hour time slot
- are offered Tuesdays – Sundays, from 9am to 4pm
- may be booked sequentially with a 15 minute change up period in between tours
- are tailored to meet the needs of your class or tour group
- are thematic and curriculum standards based
- are FREE for schools and educational groups
- are offered at a cost \$5 per person for other groups (please contact us to find out if this applies to you)
- must be arranged at least 3 weeks ahead of your desired date and time

#### Museum2Schools, Museum2AfterSchools and Digital Slide Shows

- last for one hour
- are designed for one classroom at a time; a group of no more than 40 students in an after school program; any size group
- may be booked for Tuesdays – Fridays, from 8:30am to 3:30pm
- may be booked sequentially
- are thematic and curriculum standards based
- are FREE
- must be arranged at least 3 weeks ahead of your desired date and time
- some programs may be adapted for other grades/ages
