 Leyendecker created 322 covers for the *Saturday Evening Post* and helped define the modern magazine cover as a unique art form.



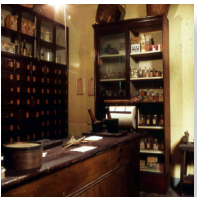
3 Holt '75 Caterpillar

 Travel back in time as you stroll down the Main Street of a typical California town at the turn-of-the-last-century.

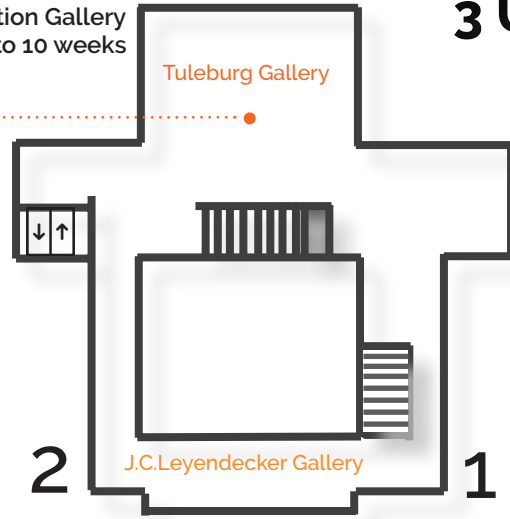


7 Emma LeDoux Trunk

 The infamous trunk is on view at the Haggin as a reminder of one of Stockton's most intriguing court cases.

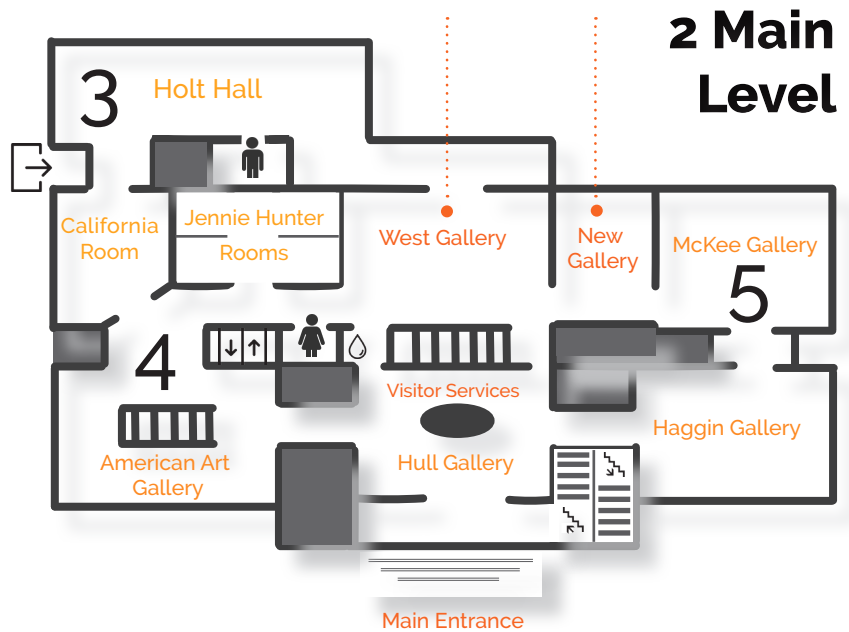
